Key Commitment 2

- All staff are trained in line with the Criteria set out in Annex C of the EYFS (November 2025). Our training providers are: NoodleNow!, Hampshire Safeguarding Children Partnership and Hampshire County Council.

Safeguarding training is refreshed as new guidance is available and staff undertake renewed training annually. The designated safeguarding lead and deputy designated safeguarding lead ensure support, advice and guidance for all staff to meet their safeguarding responsibilities by:

- Regular supervision and 1:1s, team meetings, emailed briefings and bulletins, group supervision, safeguarding procedure reviews and open dialogue between the team.

Required Training Courses:

- All staff undertake the following courses annually:
 - Arranged Marriages
 - Breast Ironing
 - Child Sexual Exploitation
 - Child Protection
 - Disguised Compliance
 - Fabricated Illness
 - Female Genital Mutilation
 - Professional Curiosity
 - Safeguarding Children (Level 2)
 - The Prevent Duty and British Values
 - Understanding Modern Slavery
 - Understanding Neglect
 - Witchcraft

- The DSL, DDSL and the DSL-L3 also undertake the following courses annually:
 - Safeguarding Children (Level 3)
 - Managing Allegations
 - CAF CON and Multi Agency Approach
 - Child Protection
 - Managing Allegations

Further training is undertaken as required.
